Short tests

- You will write short tests with the aim to check your process of learning and my process of teaching.
- Short tests cannot be retaken.
- If you are absent on two or more short tests you may be asked to write a test covering the content of the tests you have missed (the teacher will take this decision).

End of semester exams

- The exams will take place at the end of each semester.
- The exam will be one of three major exams in preDP (one exam in preDP1 and two exams in preDP2) classes to determine students' path at Diploma course.
- The exam at the end of preDP2 will cover preDP1 and preDP2 material and it will determine students' path at the Diploma level. To qualify to Higher Level course the pass grade is 70%.
- There are no retakes of these tests.
