## 1. Marking criteria:

### Grades during the term you can get for

• Short tests	Weight 1
• Activity, Homework, Group work	Weight 1
• End of the semester tests and end of the year tests (each)	Weight 4

- All grades will be in percentage. The percentage will be changed into grade given in the 1-6 scale and 1-5 scale for a short test. The grade will be awarded as follows:

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### End of unit test

- You will be informed about the date of a test at least a week in advance.

### Short tests

- You will write short tests with the aim to check your process of learning and my process of teaching.
- Short tests cannot be retaken.
- If you are absent on two or more short tests you maybe asked to write a test covering the content of the tests you have missed (the teacher will take this decision).

### Exams

- There will be 1 exam at the end of the PreDP1 and 2 exams in preDP2 (in December or January and in May or June) to determine students' path at Diploma course.
- The exam at the end of preDP2 will cover preDP1 and preDP2 material and it will determine students' path at the Diploma level.
- There are no retakes of these tests.

### Homework assignments

- You may be given homework after class.
- Homework can be assessed.

**The end of the term grade** will be calculated as the weighted mean of your grades you will get during the term and grade will be awarded as follows:

## 2. Test retake policy:

- Each end of unit test you can retake once only. The grade from the first test will be given weight 1 and the grade from the retake will be given weight 4
- If you cannot take part in the end-of-unit tests and retakes (justified absence), you will have to pass an extra test. The time and date of this test will be agreed with the teacher.

## 3. Final grade:

- **The end of the year grade** will be calculated as the weighted mean of your grades you will get during the year and grade will be awarded as follows:

## 4. Late arrivals:
